

"Holiness: Obedience & Love" 1 Peter 1:22

Key Text: "The goal of this command is love, which comes from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith" (1 Tim. 1:5)

Key Thought: We are called to purity of heart, obedience to God's truth, and a powerful love for God and one another.

There is a sign-up sheet for anyone who would like to purchase an Easter lily to beautify our church for Easter in honor or memory of a loved one.


The cost is \$8.00 and may be turned in to the church office or left in the offering plate marked for Easter lilies.
